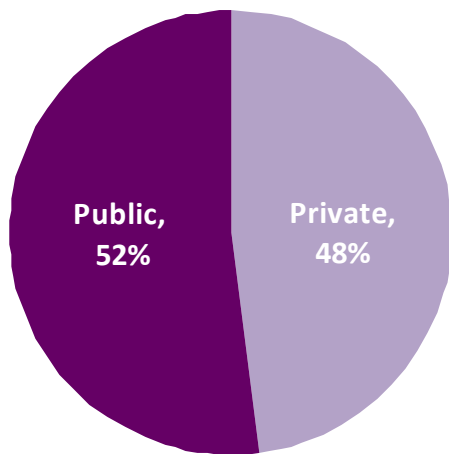

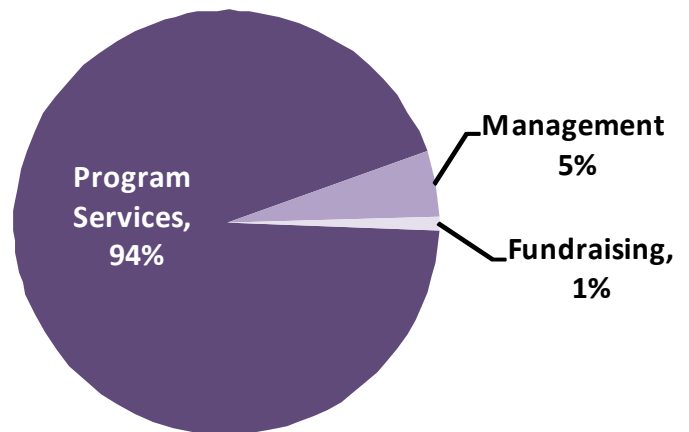

Implementing Three Major Research Grants

-  **Family Foundations Study:** This \$2.57 million NICHD grant seeks to determine the impact of adding a co-parenting intervention to ongoing home visitation. The target enrolment is 300 father/mother pairs.
-  **Childhood Home Injury Prevention Study (CHIP):** This \$3.1 million NICHD grant is to conduct a clinical trial on an injury prevention intervention developed by K.J. Phelan, M.D., a CCHMC pediatrician. The study will recruit 1,000 ECS mothers over a 5 year period.
-  **Mother and Infant Depression Improvement Study 2 (MIDIS2):** This \$2.8 million NIMH grant replicates and extends the MIDIS study by comparing IH-CBT to a second therapy. The study will recruit 220 ECS mothers over a 5 year period.
